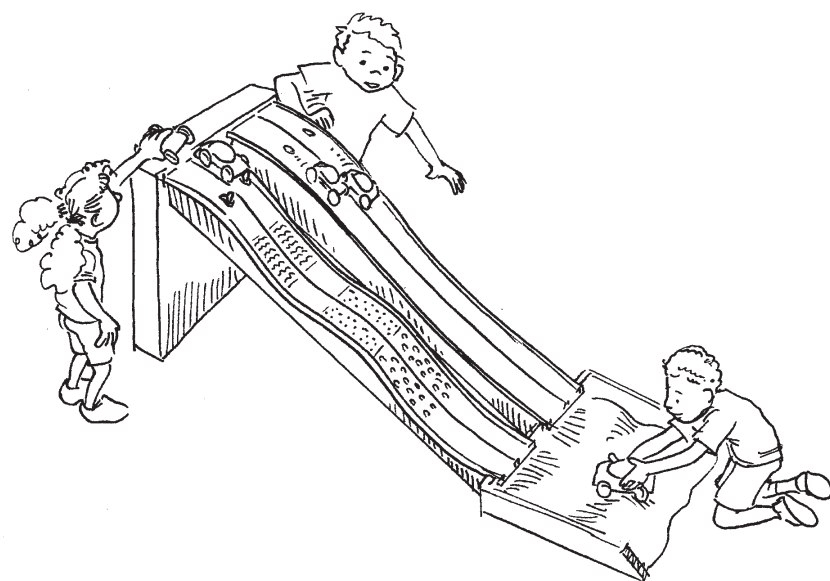

Based on the themes of *challenge* and *discovery*, this exhibit will be created from plans provided by certified children's exhibit designers and will encourage interactivity—exercising its users both mentally and physically. It will meet the highest standards for safety and durability, and will serve Rochester-area youth for several years.

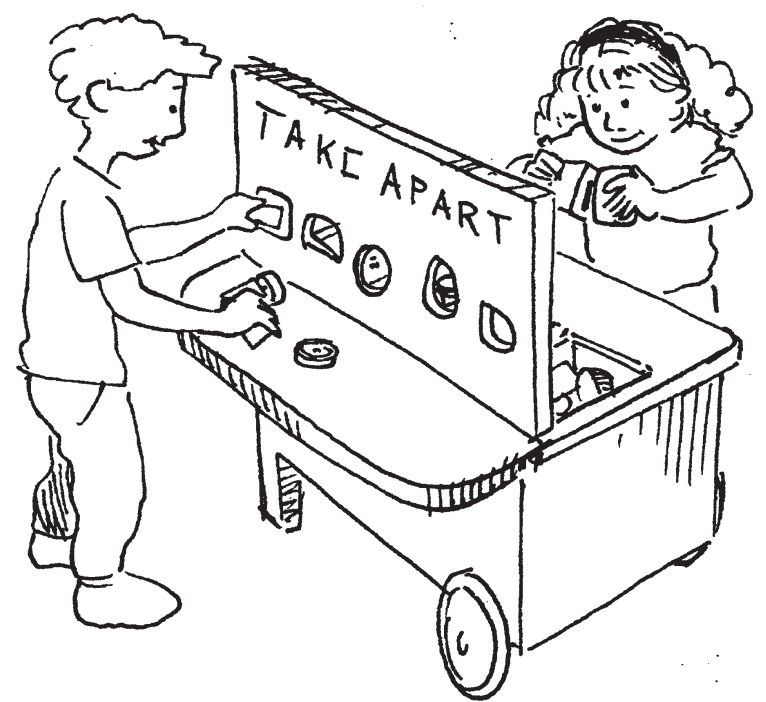

What your donation provides: Proposed Mobile Exhibit Ready-Set-Go-Raceway

Kids can design and test their own race cars using Automoblox models, making choices about color and the shape of materials that affect their racing capacity. At the *Build It! Station*, kids choose from car parts sorted in bins to design the car of their dreams. Nearby, two sets of *Race Tracks*—or four tracks total—allow kids to race cars against each other. Two of the tracks veer straight downhill; the other two are wavy. All four feature a starter lever, which kids press to release the cars and start them on their journey. After racing, kids will enjoy taking apart their cars and sending parts back into bins through a shape sorter at the *Build It! Station*.



At the *Build It! Station*, kids choose from car parts sorted in bins to design the car of their dreams.
